## Homework Guidelines

The table below serves as a guide to the amount of time we expect children to spend on aspects of school work at home. As part of our partnership with parents we would expect this to be supervised and for many of the tasks, shared (as with games etc). It is important that we receive feedback as to whether children could do the work set with reasonable ease. If it is obviously too difficult we would expect that information to come back to the teacher as it has implications for classwork.

| Year | Task and Subject | Amount of Time <br> to be Spent |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Year 2 | Reading | One extended period of <br> 30 mins per week |
|  | Spelling | 5 mins $4 \times$ per week |
|  | Numeracy | 20 mins $1 \times$ per week |

The table is a general guide. Some children are set differing amounts of work depending on their ability or perhaps as a result of a programme on which they are working. This would generally be managed as a discrete arrangement with parents.

Homework is usually set as outlined above but there are times in the school year when this pattern is not appropriate (eg Christmas rehearsals, test weeks etc)

Always see the class teacher if your child has had a problem with homework
