




Literacy

- Developing descriptive writing of Fantasy Settings
- Developing imagination through story writing focusing on stories by Julia Donaldson
- Consolidating phonic sounds previously learnt and learning alternative pronunciations of sounds e.g 'ou' in **out**, shoulder, could.
- Using full stops, capital letters, question marks, exclamation marks and adjectives.
- Information texts



Mathematics



- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10's
- Addition & Subtraction using a hundred square
- Pairs of numbers that total 10, 20 and some to 100
- Measuring capacity and related problem solving.
- Doubling and halving numbers, quantities and objects including finding halves and quarters of shapes.
- Fractions of shapes, amounts and quantities.
- Developing a deeper understanding of 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- Solving problems in a variety of different contexts.
- Beginning to develop simple multiplication and division.



Science

Plants

- Exploring plants in our local environment
- Looking at different plants
- To understand what a healthy plant needs
- Plants we can eat/not eat and parts of plants we can eat/not eat.

Computing

- Developing an understanding of animations
- Using a simple animation program



Art

- Studying the work of different artist - linked to plants focusing on Georgia O'Keefe and Vincent Van Gogh
- Using a range of different mediums to create pictures



Topic Work

- Comparing hot and cold places i.e. Africa and Iceland

Please make sure that PE kits are clearly labelled with your child's name and **ALWAYS** in school.


